## MINNESOTA STATUTE 124D.52 (SUBD. 8, A)



The commissioner shall provide for a standard adult high school diploma to persons who:

Are not eligible for K-12 services;

Do not have a high school diploma; and

Successfully complete an ABE program of instruction approved by the commissioner of education necessary to earn an adult high school diploma

### MINNESOTA STATUTE 124D.52 (SUBD. 8, B)

Persons participating in approved ABE adult diploma programs must:

Demonstrate the competencies, knowledge, and skills

Be equally well prepared and qualified by employers and postsecondary





### STANDARD REQUIREMENTS


Align with K-12 academic standards pertinent to adult learners in:

- Language Arts, includes reading, writing, listening, speaking
- 2. Mathematics
- 3. Social Studies
- 4. Science
- Employability & Career Awareness, includes digital literacy

# DEMONSTRATING COMPETENCY

#### Options

- Prior experience, including K-12 & college courses, job experience & training
- 2. Test verified knowledge
- 3. ABE instruction and course completion
- 4. Applied and experiential learning, including contextualized projects



### **NEW STANDARD ADULT DIPLOMA PROCESS**

Intake

- Assess literacy skills
- Prior experiencebased Competency verification
- Identify student goals (career, learning, etc.)
- Develop individualized learning plan

Instruction English Language

Arts

- Math
- Social Studies
- Science
- Career Development and **Employability** Skills

Post-test learners

**Evaluation** 

- Track progress towards diploma and goals
- Revise plan
- Provide additional support services as needed

**Graduating Advising** Session

- Ensure completion of necessary competencies
- Create transitions plan to students' future goals
- Provide additional support services as needed
